

Active Groups

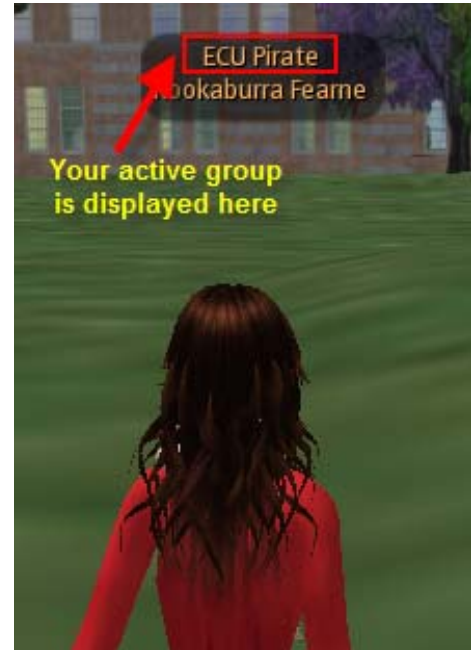
As you work with Second Life you'll often find many places will invite you to join a group. These groups are useful for people to update you on events, notices, and changes that occur on the different spaces. You can be a member of up to 25 groups; however, you may only have one **ACTIVE** group.

Your **active group** is the group that your avatar is currently associated with and is displayed above your head and name.

In addition to the group title, your active group is also the feature that tells Second Life if you are allowed to work on a certain space.

On ECU's virtual islands, you must have our group, **ECU Pirates!**, as your active group or you will be unable to build, create, or modify any objects on our space.

It is very easy for your group to be changed, especially if you have recently joined a group on another island such as fashion groups, shopping mall groups, etc.



Checking Your Group Status

1. To check your group status, click on the Communicate tab in the bottom left corner of your screen.
2. Then click on the Groups tab at the top of the Communicate window. In this window, you will see a list of all the groups you have joined. Your active group title will appear in **bold**.



Changing Your Group Status

1. Under the Group tab in your Communicate window, highlight the group that you want to activate.
2. Once highlighted, click on the activate button to the right of the list. When the group is active, the group name will appear in bold and your activate button will be disabled. You may then close the window
